Nsobe Trust School is an African school with a difference. Living in a country with a dire rural education system, Fiona Tomlinson believes in offering not only education in the 3 R's but also in health and social matters, life skills, and most importantly a quality, Christian based education with employment opportunity.

In Rural Zambia there are not enough schools. There was no school accessible to the children in this area of the Copperbelt. Ninety percent of the children's parents are illiterate and live way below the poverty line. To offer hope and the chance of an educated future Nsobe Trust School was started in 2009 by Fiona Tomlinson, who with her husband runs Nsobe Game Camp near Ndola. Having started with a few pupils there are now 260 in 9 Grades, from Reception to Grade 8, taught by a great Head and 12 dedicated teachers for whom we are asking you to help pay a small wage. There is a daily feeding scheme.

Fiona's vision is to grow a Grade a year until reaching Grade 12 (the GCSE level) and then create a natural resources college where students can learn agricultural, wildlife management and tourism disciplines. The college will also teach theory in IT, HR, Business Admin and Christian morals. Graduates will then be placed in private sector projects and will be able to create and manage their own rural projects, providing much needed natural resources development and wealth and job creation in a land that could feed Africa.

Nothing is deducted for administration! The school is one of very few in Zambia offering a total and extended private education to very poor children.
